

## Who's in Control?

## Who's in Control?


(2 Chronicles 20:13-15, 17-18)

People from Judah were afraid that a large army would attack them. They asked God for help. God sent a message to Jahaziel for all the people: "Do not be frightened or terrified. The battle is not yours. It is God's. God is in control.

"You will not fight this battle. Take your po-

sition, stand still, and see the victory of the Lord God for you! Tomorrow, go out to face them. The Lord is with you."

Jehoshaphat bowed down with his face touching the ground. Everyone from Judah and the people who lived in Jerusalem immediately bowed down to worship the Lord God.
