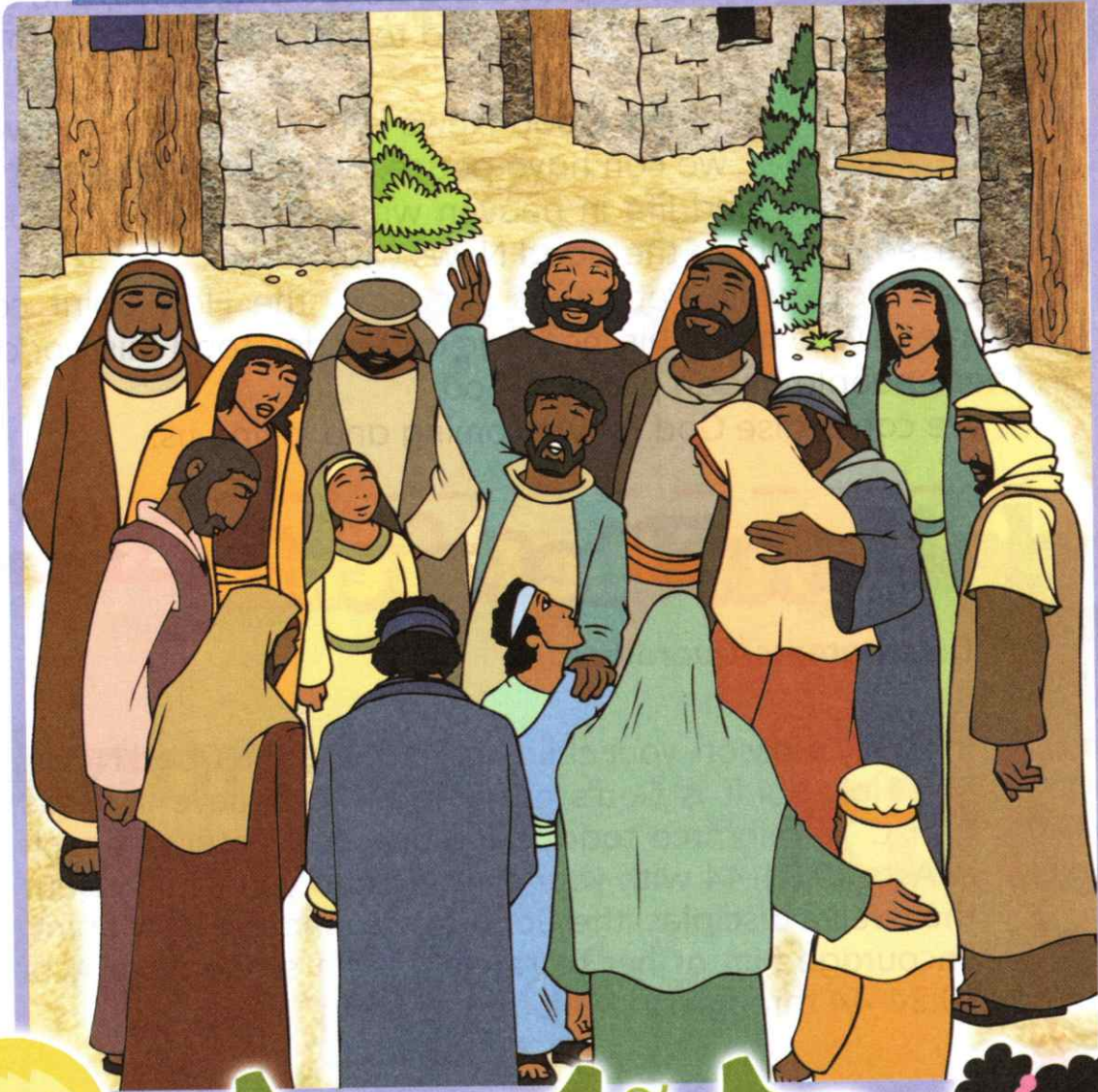


# Including Everyone

Lesson Scripture: Acts 10:34-47

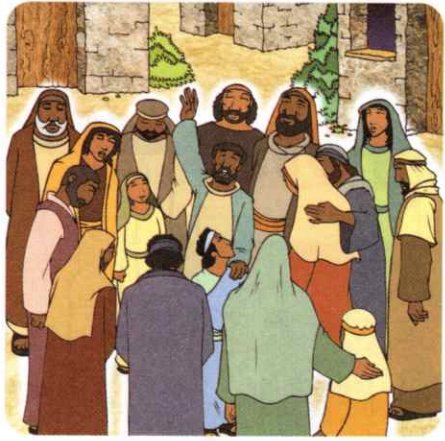


## Key Verses
