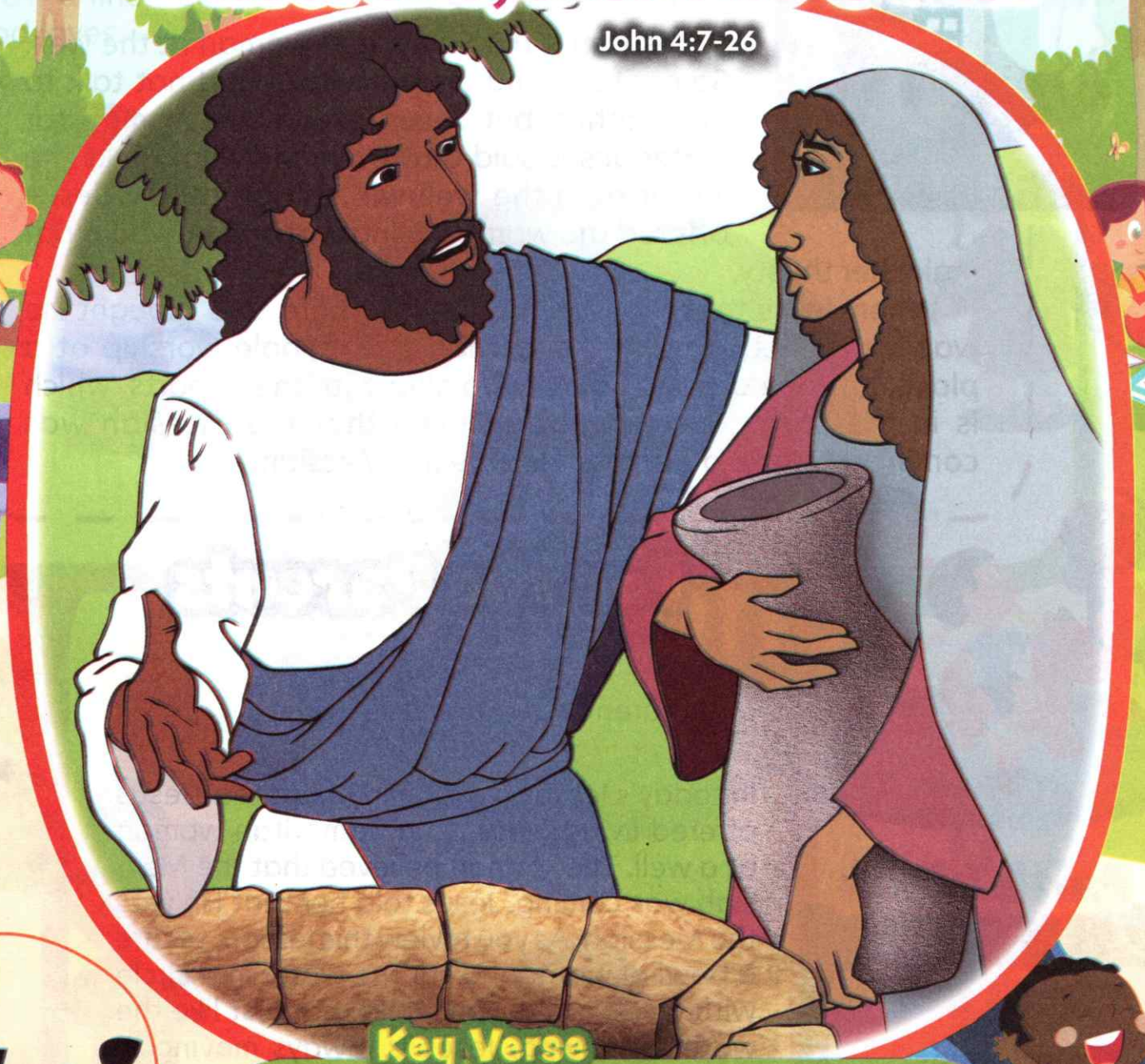


Different, but the Same

Different, but the Same

(John 4:7-26)

Jesus met the Samaritan woman at the well. Samaritans and Jews normally did not talk to each other, but Jesus asked the woman for water. Jesus said that everyone who drinks the water from the well will still be thirsty. Jesus offered the woman living water that would not

make her thirsty.

When Jesus told the woman about her life, she thought He was a prophet. He told the woman that people worship at a place, but one day they would worship with their hearts, which is in the Spirit. The woman believed that the Messiah was coming. Jesus told her that He was the Messiah.
