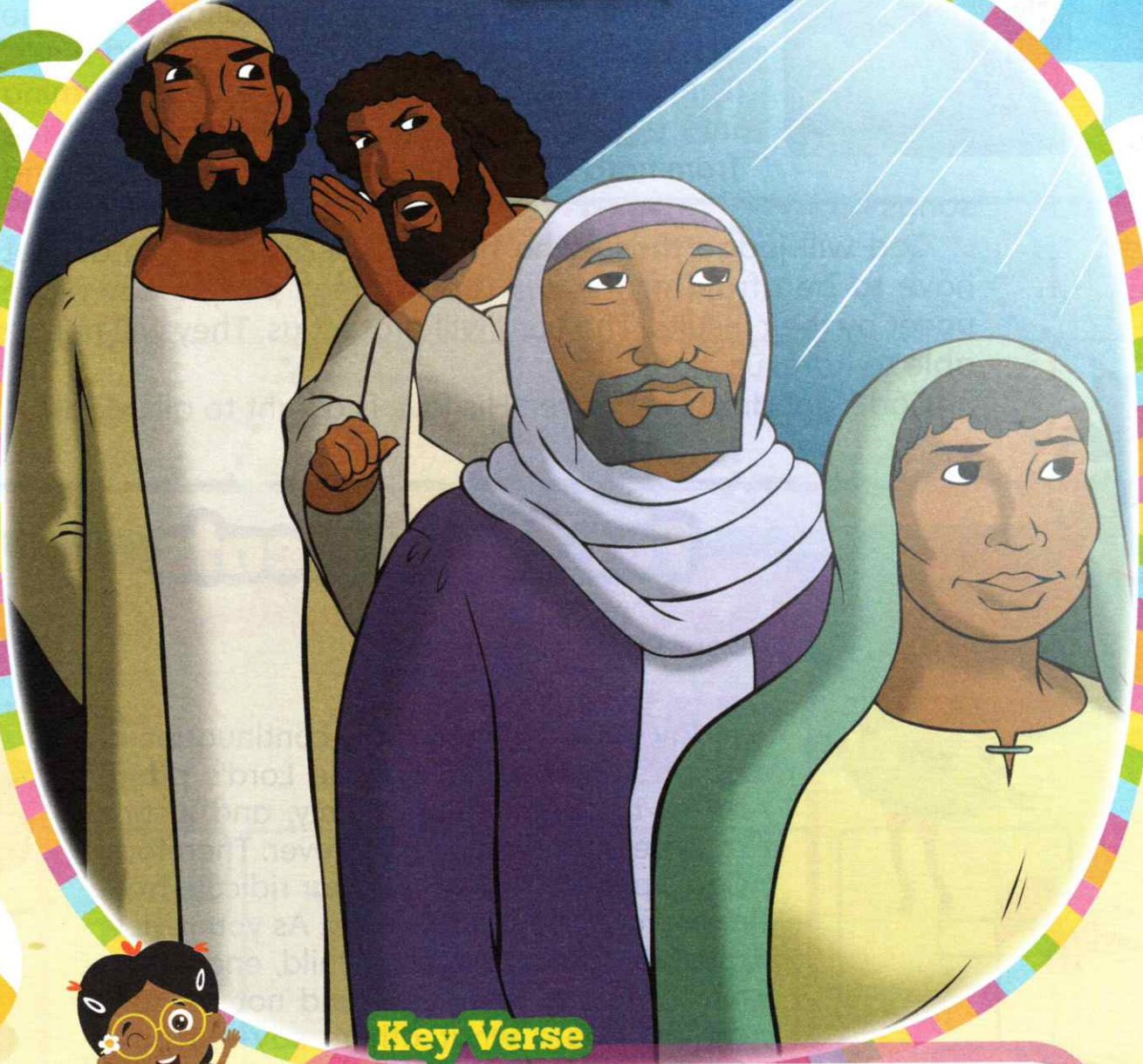




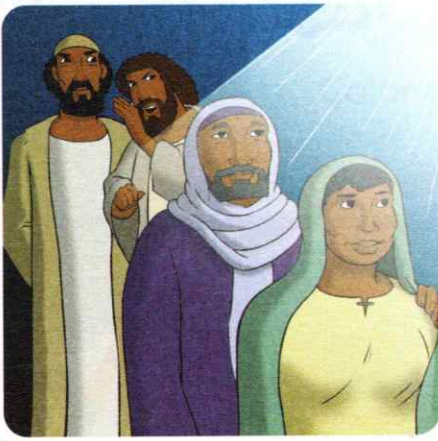
# Freedom!

## Freedom!

(Isaiah 51:1-8)

Isaiah said this to God's people: "Listen, all you who try to live right and follow God. The Lord God will send comfort during hard times. Things will get better, just like a desert turning into a garden. People will be happy to be free from hard times. They will give thanks and sing

songs."

God will judge those who have caused harm. We do not have to be afraid of the *evil* (bad) things people say or be upset by their insults. The Lord will protect us. They will not be able to harm us.

God's goodness is forever. His love is a light to all people.

## For the Parents

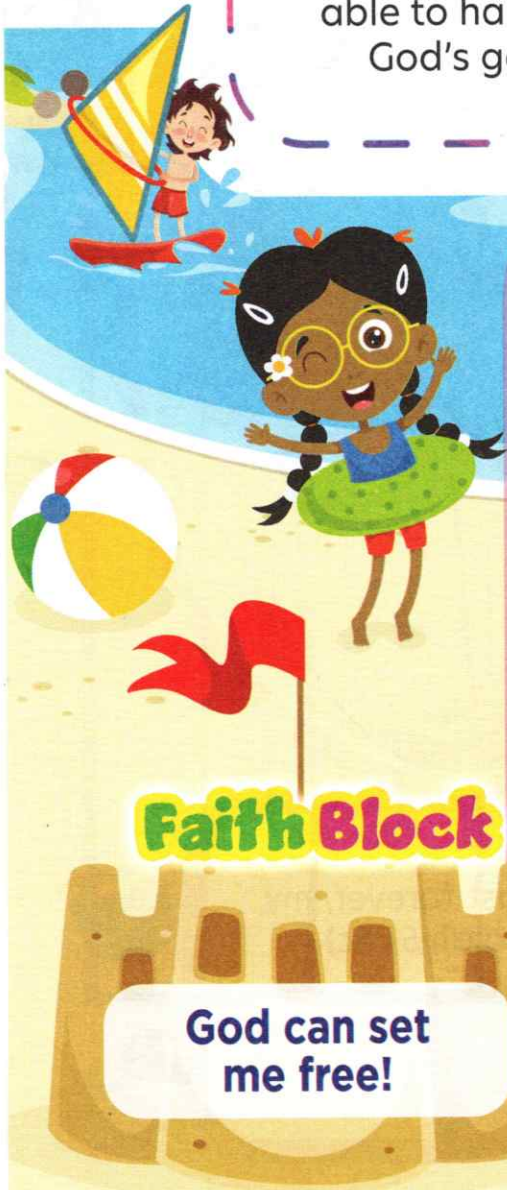
Dear Parents/Guardians,

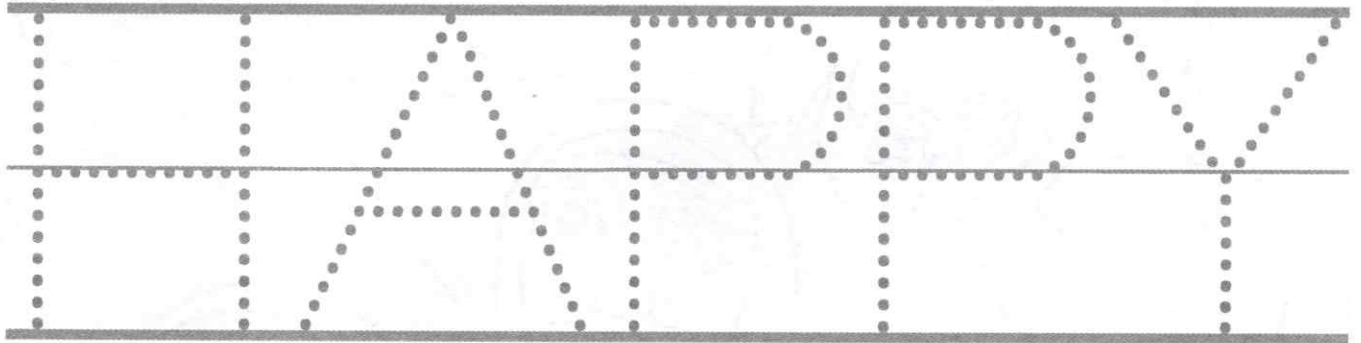
