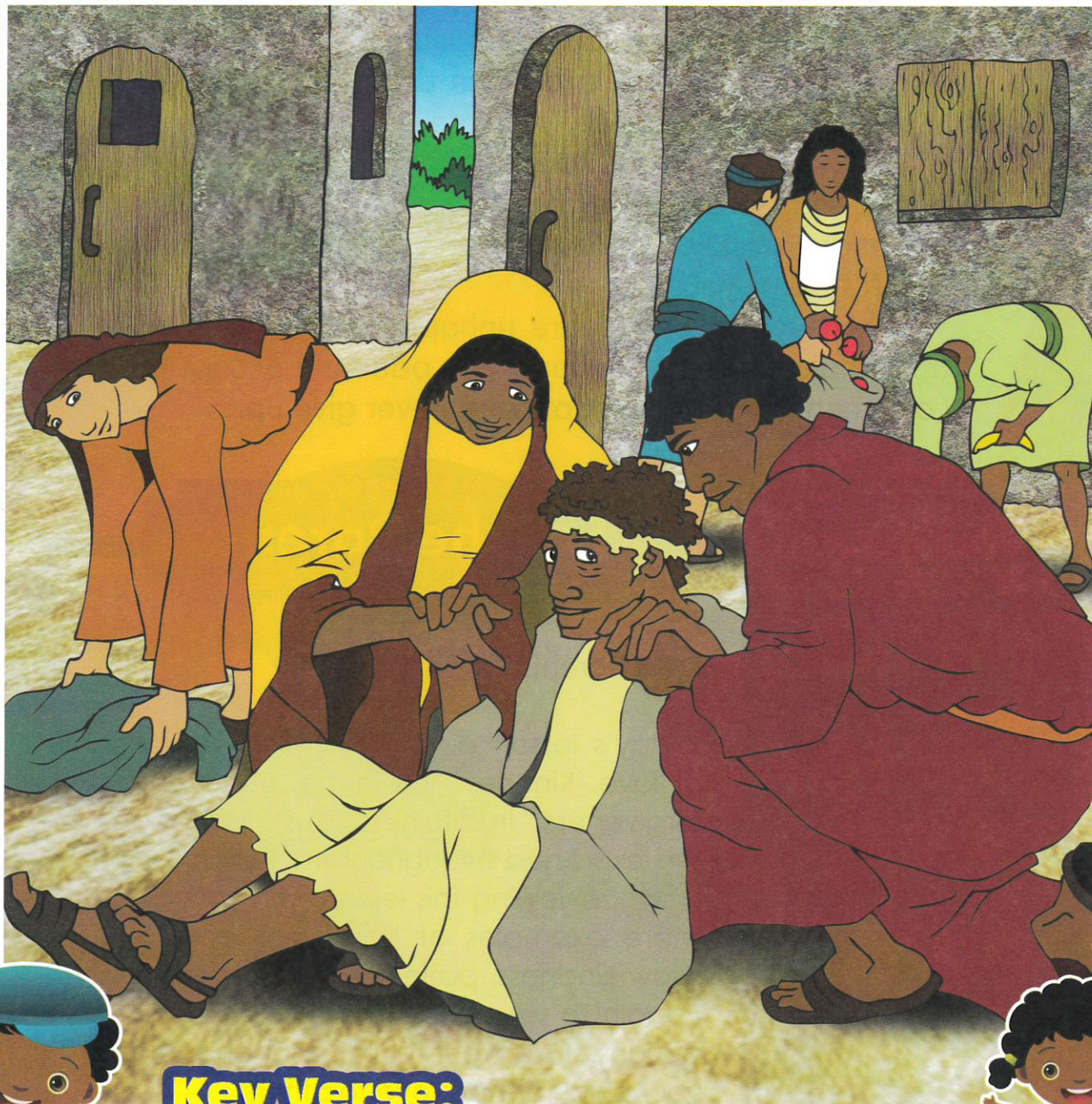


Giving the Gift of Love

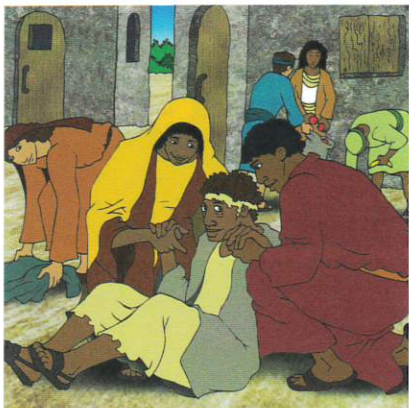
Lesson Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 12-13

Giving the Gift of Love

(1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 12-13)

What is love? In the Bible, we learn that you care a lot about others when you love them. The Bible defines those who love as patient and kind. They are not jealous or want what belongs to someone else. They do not brag and are not proud. They are not rude or selfish. They do not get angry quickly. They forgive wrong things done and easily say, "I forgive you."

When you love, you are unhappy with bad choices. The truth makes you happy, and you patiently accept all things. Love means you trust, hope, and never give up.
